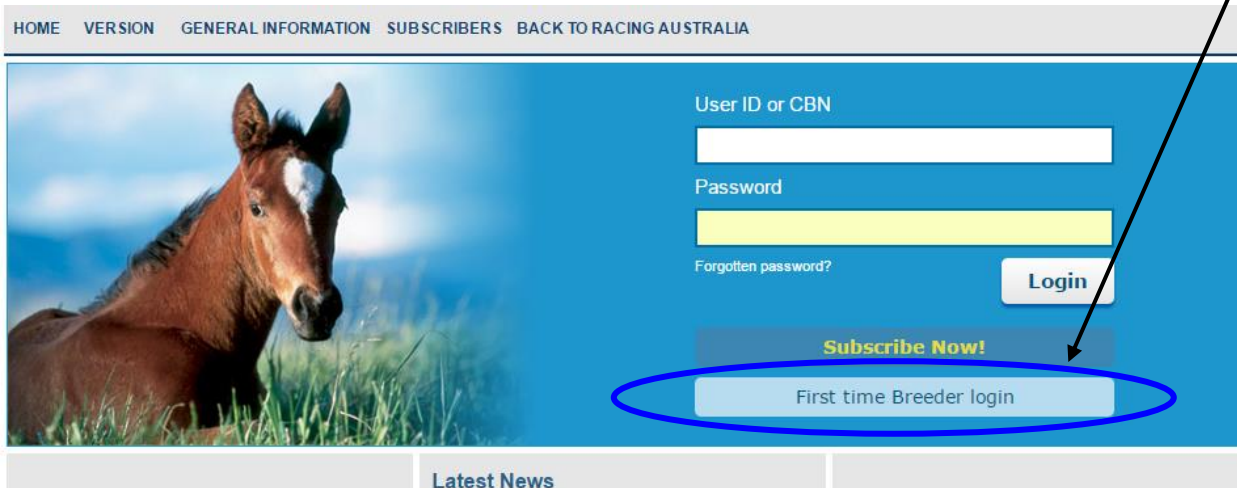

## Logging In

**New Users – if you are registered with the Australian Stud Book as a Contact Breeder with a current email address recorded, and would like to register for access to the Online Stallion Return program, select**

If you have a User ID (or CBN) and password issued, enter your User ID and password on the Australian Stud Book home page, and select Login



When you have successfully logged in, select the 'Online Services' heading followed by the 'Stallion Returns' / 'Lodge Stallion Return' option in the drop down menu:



# LOGGING A STALLION RETURN

## Step One – Adding a stallion

Enter the stallion's name, including suffix for stallions other than (AUS) and select Continue >>

## Step Two – Stallion details

Select the category in which your stallion will be standing, from the list available, (or whether the stallion may have died or retired) and select Continue >>

## LODGING A BREEDING HORSE REGISTRATION

### Step One – Finding a Horse

To lodge a Breeding Horse Registration for Horses previously returned, **select**

[Load](#)

To lodge a Breeding Horse Registration for a new Horse, enter the Horse's name, including the suffix for horses other than (AUS), Aus ID or Microchip Number followed by [Search](#). Then select the correct Horse from the possible matches on the list displayed.

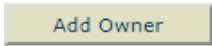
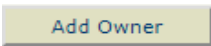

## Step Four – Define Owner Details

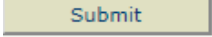
1. Select an owner type: Person, Company/Stud or Syndicate;
2. Select one of the options available to define owners;
  - a) Add Myself – Adds a line with details of the logged in CBN as defined in Stud Book.
  - b) Add Other – This provides two options:
    - i. Enter CBN – If the owner has a Contact Breeder Number, then enter it in the provided space and click  button to add a line with details as defined in Stud Book.
    - ii. Enter Manually – If the owner has no Contact Breeder Number or you don't know owner's Contact Breeder Number then manually enter requested details on provided spaces and click  button to add a line.

*NOTE – You can lodge a Breeding Horse Registration for any breeding Horse, regardless of whether you have previously returned the horse. You must be authorised by the owner/s to lodge a Breeding Horse Registration on their behalf.*

## Step Five – Submit Breeding Horse Registration

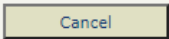
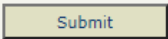
After entering Location of Horse, Horse Owners and corresponding Percentage Ownerships, please check all details are correct.

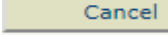
Certify that you are authorised to lodge the Breeding Horse Registration and agree to be bound by the *Terms & Conditions - Breeding Horse Registration* by ticking the corresponding check box.

When you have completed entering all details and wish to proceed, click the  button.

*Note – Upon submission, you will receive an email confirming the successful submission and all listed owners with email addresses will be notified regarding the ownership with relevant details. Racing Australia Owners & Breeders Services will be in contact with listed owners with no email address to seek acceptance of ownership.*

*The Breeding Horse Registration will be provisionally lodged subject to all listed owners accepting the ownership by selecting 'Accept' in the email sent to them.*

*Provisionally lodged Breeding Horse Registrations will be finalised once all listed owners have accepted their share percentage.*

*If any of the listed owners reject the ownership by selecting 'Decline' in the email or if there are any disputes in nomination, Racing Australia Owners & Breeders Services will contact you and/or relevant listed owners to resolve the dispute.*

*You will be notified by email once the Breeding Horse Registration is finalised and the Record of Breeding Horse Ownership certificate will be forwarded to the Managing Owner by email.*
